

**INFORMATION SHEET ON  
INDIAN RED CROSS, SOCIETY DISTRICT BRANCH, SUNDARGARH**

The Indian Red Cross Society District Branch, Sundargarh and its Executive Committee were constituted in the year 1976 as per rule of IRCS. The Collector & District Magistrate, Sundargarh is functioning as Ex-Officio Chairman, IRCS, District Branch, Sundargarh.

The Collection and Expenditure Position towards IRCS, Dist. Branch, Sundargarh during the year 2010-11 is given below.

1. Maintenance of Old Age Home, Rabondihi

The IRCS District Branch, Sundargarh is running an Old Age Home (Biswa Bandhu Jarashram) at Rabondihi of Karla Gram Panchayat in Sadar Block. The Old Age Home, Rabaondihi was established on 02.10.1989. At present 24 inmates (15 males & 9 females) are residing there. Rs.9,600/- (Rupees Nine Thousand Six hundred) only @ Rs.400 per inmate is being provided each month towards maintenance charges and Rs. 3,300/- monthly honorarium of staff amounting to being paid to Secretary, Dharmanandan Yuvak Sangha Sikipani is looking after the same.

2. Running of Homeopathic Dispensaries.

The IRCS, District Branch, Sundargarh is running two Homeopathic Dispensaries one at Surda of Tangarpali Block and another at Tendra of Bonai Block. The total Monthly honorarium of Rs.14,431/- is being paid to Surda Medical Officer and his staff. Further Monthly honorarium of Rs.9,800/- is being paid to Tendra Medical Officer and his staff. Treatment of diseases along with medicines free of cost has been provided to the needy patients of the area. Homeopathic medicine worth of Rs.1,51,168/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty one Thousand One Hundred Sixty eight) only out of Red Cross Fund has been supplied to these two Dispensaries during the year 2010-11.

3. Financial Assistance to poor people/Patients.

This is the regular humanitarian activity of IRCS, Dist. Branch, Sundargarh for Poor Patients and victims of mishappenings etc. in the district. All possible financial assistance are provided from time to time for purchase of medicine to the patients of ~~Rs. 2,~~ <sup>Rs. 2,</sup> 02,642/- has been spent during 2010-11 towards financial assistance to poor patients.

4. Establishment of Revolving Fund.

IRCS, District Branch, Sundargarh has created Revolving Fund at Sub-Collector office in order to extend immediate relief to the victims of road accidents and elephant menace etc. A sum of Rs.13, 25,000/- has already been placed at the disposal of all 03 Sub-Collectors and all 03 DFOs of the District.


5. Blind and Deaf School, Bandhapali

Rs.1,35,000/- as advance has been placed to DSWO-Cum-Honorary Secretary, SARTHAK, Sundargarh for running of Class-VIII in school for SARTHAK during the year 2010-11 ( for this academic year) .

Further Rs.66,000/- as advance has been placed to DSWO-Cum-Honorary Secretary SARTHAK for honorarium of staff for running of Class-VIII in school for SARTHAK during the year 2010-11.


6. Blood Donation Programme
